



## **SCAPPS Student Support Initiative – Travel Awards**

### **Awards Overview and Application Form**

#### **Award Overview**

The SCAPPS Student Support Initiative - Travel Awards are intended to support students with financial need to attend the annual SCAPPS conference. There are two initiatives/options that students may apply for:

- 1) Student Conference Travel Award (up to \$750 per student) – open to all student members. This funding is intended to support students with financial need to attend the annual SCAPPS conference. Money can be used to offset the cost of conference registration fees, travel, accommodation, etc. Amounts awarded take into consideration geographic location impacting the cost of travel to the conference location.
- 2) Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) Student Conference Travel Award (up to \$750 per student) – open to all student members who self-identify as belonging to an equity-deserving group. This funding is intended to support students with financial need to attend the annual SCAPPS conference. Money can be used to offset the cost of conference registration fees, travel, accommodation, etc. Amounts awarded take into consideration geographic location impacting the cost of travel to the conference location.

#### **Eligibility**

Applicants to both initiatives must be registered in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at the time of application or at the time of the conference. Applicants must not have already received financial support from SCAPPS in the previous two years.

Applicants to the EDI Student Conference Travel Award must self-identify that they belong to an equity-deserving group. Note: equity-deserving groups include, but are not limited to, women, Indigenous Peoples (First Nations, Inuit and Métis), persons with disabilities, members of visible minority/racialized groups and members of LGBTQ2+ communities (see the Tri-Agency EDI Action Plan for 2018–2025 and EDI Dimensions charter for more information: [https://www.nserc-crsng.gc.ca/InterAgency-Interorganismes/EDI-EDI/Dimensions-Charter\\_Dimensions-Charte\\_eng.asp](https://www.nserc-crsng.gc.ca/InterAgency-Interorganismes/EDI-EDI/Dimensions-Charter_Dimensions-Charte_eng.asp) and [https://www.nserc-crsng.gc.ca/InterAgency-Interorganismes/EDI-EDI/Action-Plan\\_Plan-dAction\\_eng.asp](https://www.nserc-crsng.gc.ca/InterAgency-Interorganismes/EDI-EDI/Action-Plan_Plan-dAction_eng.asp))



The student's faculty supervisor must also sign the application form and attest to the student's eligibility and the financial need to attend the SCAPPS conference.

**Adjudication and Announcement of Support**

Applications will be screened for eligibility and entered into a lottery for funding support. Eligible applications will be randomly selected for funding support and the students will be notified of the results by email.

Details regarding applicants and students who are provided with funding will not be publicly announced. Information will be shared about the number of students supported through each initiative and the amount of funding awarded, but students' names and identifying information will not be publicly shared and will only be reviewed by the SCAPPS Executive during the screening process.
